Abstract di progetto

The general objective of the project will be to implement a socio-economic study on the sustainable entrepreneurship socialisation of disadvantaged actors due to generational and gender issues. The two target categories of the survey will be young women, from an intersectional perspective. The achievement of the general objective of the project could produce impacts on several interrelated levels. At the socio-economic level, actions on entrepreneurship education can contrast inequalities for the inclusion of women and the younger generation. At the scientific level, the proposed transdisciplinary study will implement the theoretical-conceptual framework while, with regards to the project's outputs, the following will be produced: a dataset on the relevant variables on the topic under study; a mapping of the best practices to facilitate entrepreneurship education and to support the social inclusion of women and of the younger generations from a social equity perspective; guidelines to foster the valorisation of socio-economic diversities.

The project is innovative and original in the Italian context, not only with regards to the objectives, the selected target and the perspective it takes, trans-disciplinary and intersectional, but also from a methodological point of view: indeed, in addition to the survey (structured questionnaire) and to the qualitative in-depth study (focused qualitative interviews), the project will carry out an analysis of best practices. Furthermore, using the Delphi technique with experts the project will contribute to the construction of policy-making scenarios for social cohesion and inclusion strategies.
